Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Early works notification

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. The project is expected to support approximately 50 jobs per year, averaged over the life of the construction period.

Thank you to those members of the community who attended information session about the project in November 2021.

Prior to major construction commencing in April 2022, early works are required to prepare the site.

Demolition works

Property demolition works will begin shortly along the north eastern side of Glen Osmond Road, at the junction of Main Avenue and Glen Osmond Road. These demolition works are expected to occur from week commencing 31 January 2022, and be complete late March 2022, weather permitting.

As part of the standard process, an asbestos assessment will be completed prior to any demolition works starting. Any identified asbestos will be removed. All asbestos removal works will be carried out by a licensed asbestos contractor in accordance with the Environmental Protection Authority Guidelines. These measures will ensure the safety of the community and workers.

Utility services relocation works

Initial service relocation works are planned to also start in late January 2022. These activities are expected to be complete in July 2022, weather permitting.

Works will include the relocation of telecommunications infrastructure, relocation of SA Power Networks infrastructure. APA Gas works and SA Water main alterations.

Individual service providers, including SA Power Networks and Telecommunications providers, will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with some weekend works as required. In order to minimise traffic impacts and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, some night works may also be required. Advance notice will be provided if night works are required.





Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
