Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Project Update

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

In response to feedback received, the right turn from Fullarton Road into Glen Osmond Road, heading towards the South Eastern Freeway, will be reinstated.

Infrastructure upgrade projects often have a range of social, environmental and technical factors to consider, including feedback from various stakeholders. The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is committed to identifying outcomes that deliver on the project's objectives, whilst balancing the needs of the various stakeholders, as much as practically possible.

The design is currently being updated to reinstate this right turn. This updated design will be shared with the community in the coming months.

Construction activities currently underway are not impacted by this design change.
