

# Brighton Road and Edwards Street Junction upgrade

## Project update

The Australian and South Australian governments are upgrading the Brighton Road and Edwards Street junction at South Brighton.

### What's happening?

We are installing traffic lights and signalised pedestrian crossings at the junction. This will improve road safety and access through the junction for all road users. It will also improve access to local businesses, especially during peak periods.

Refer to the concept plan over the page to see what the upgrade includes.

**Major works are now starting at the junction with Project completion expected in the third quarter of 2024.**

To minimise disruption to all road users, the majority of works will be undertaken at night between 7pm to 6am (weather permitting).

No night works will be undertaken Saturday nights. Friday night works may be required intermittently.

### Upcoming works will include:

- removal of kerbing, stobie pole footings, footpaths, road signage and street furniture
- service utilities relocations
- drainage work
- road widening activities.

Some day works will be required. Day time works will typically take place Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm. To safely undertake these works, we will occasionally need to

temporarily close Edwards Street at the intersection of Brighton Road. We will let you know in advance of this occurring.

### What to expect

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work zone as needed. Please observe onsite signage and direction of traffic controllers.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

### Pedestrian access changes

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times throughout the works however there will be some temporary changes to access. Please follow directional signage when travelling through the area.

Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

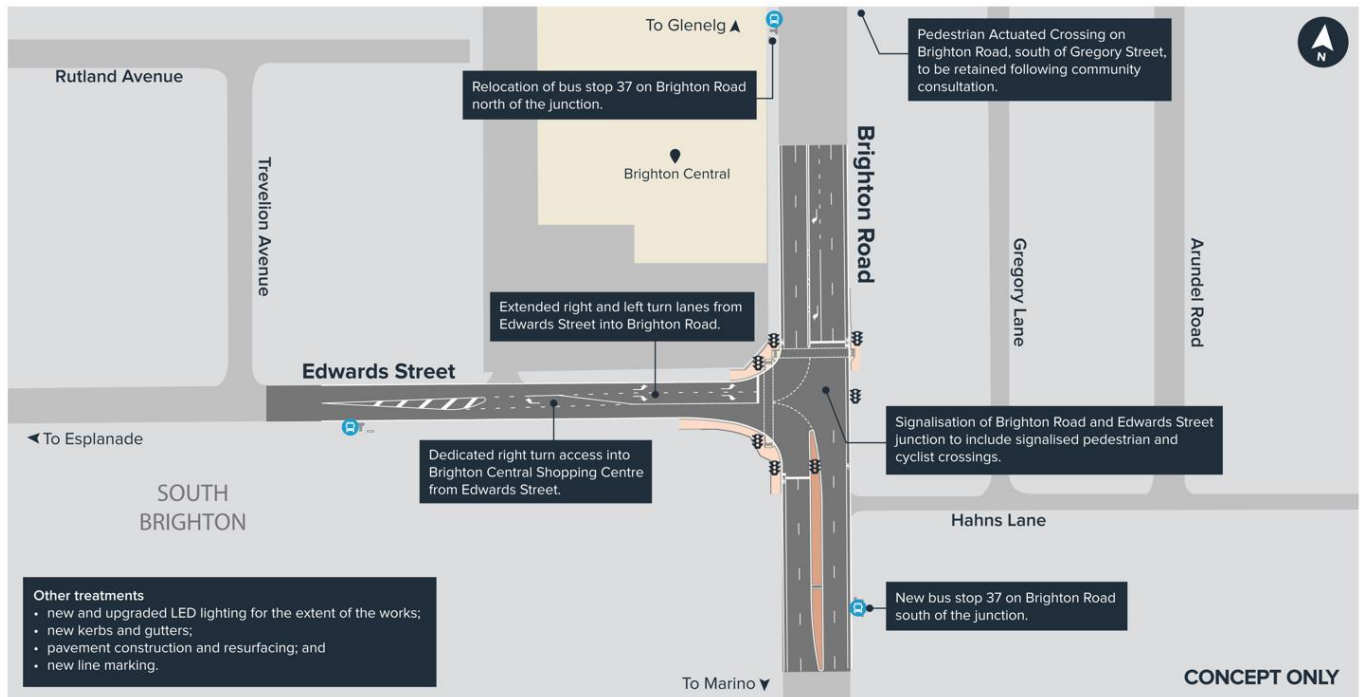
