

Port Lincoln Intersection Safety Upgrade Project

Night Works

We are undertaking improvements to the Eyre Peninsula road network. These works are funded by the Australian and South Australian governments. This project includes upgrading four key intersections along Lincoln Highway through central Port Lincoln.

What's happening:

Pavement rehabilitation works will be undertaken along Lincoln Highway through central Port Lincoln from Flinders Highway to Mortlock Terrace, including the parking bays. To minimise impacts to the local community these works will be carried out at night and will move progressively along the Highway as the works progress.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Local detours for light vehicles will be in place during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Access for heavy vehicles will be maintained.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access. We'll put up signs to guide you to other routes if needed.

We'll maintain access for properties and business throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
