Lincoln Highway Safety Upgrades, Lipson to Tumby bay

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to the Lincoln Highway between Lipson and Tumby Bay. These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

What's happening:

We are undertaking safety upgrades at various locations on this section of the Lincoln Highway. Works will include:

- Shoulder widening and sealing
- Culvert extensions
- Pavement line marking
- Audio Tactile Line Marking
- Vegetation management

The Lincoln Highway will remain open at all times, however, to do this work safely we will have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas as required. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours speed and lane restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions. You will still be able to access homes and properties. If we need to limit or impact access, we'll let you know ahead of time.
