Lincoln Highway Safety Upgrades, Cowell to Lipson

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to the Lincoln Highway between Cowell and Lipson. These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

What's happening:

We are undertaking safety upgrades at various locations on this section of the Lincoln Highway. Works will include:

- Shoulder widening and sealing
- Culvert extensions
- Vegetation management
- Pavement marking
- Audio Tactile Line Marking

The upgrades are designed to improve safety, freight efficiency, and support regional economic growth and improve safety for all road users.

How this affects you:

The Lincoln Highway will remain open at all times, however, to do this work safely we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas as required. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours speed and lane restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions. You will still be able to access homes and properties. If we need to limit or impact access, we'll let you know ahead of time.
