



John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

Project Update

We are upgrading the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale. This forms part of the State Government's election commitments, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and make travel easier for all users. This upgrade will also help support growth in the Lyell McEwin health precinct.

Design update

Thank you to everyone who has provided feedback about this project. Local insights gathered throughout this process, along with input from key stakeholders and technical data, has been used to help inform the development of the final design. This final design for the upgrade is now available. Please see over the page.

The final design includes:

- Installation of traffic lights at the junction to improve safety for all road users
- A new dedicated right turn lane onto Haydown Road to improve traffic flow
- New and upgraded LED lighting to improve safety
- New kerb and gutter
- New and upgraded road surface and new line marking
- Retention of the existing pedestrian actuated (push-button) crossing east of the junction on John Rice Avenue

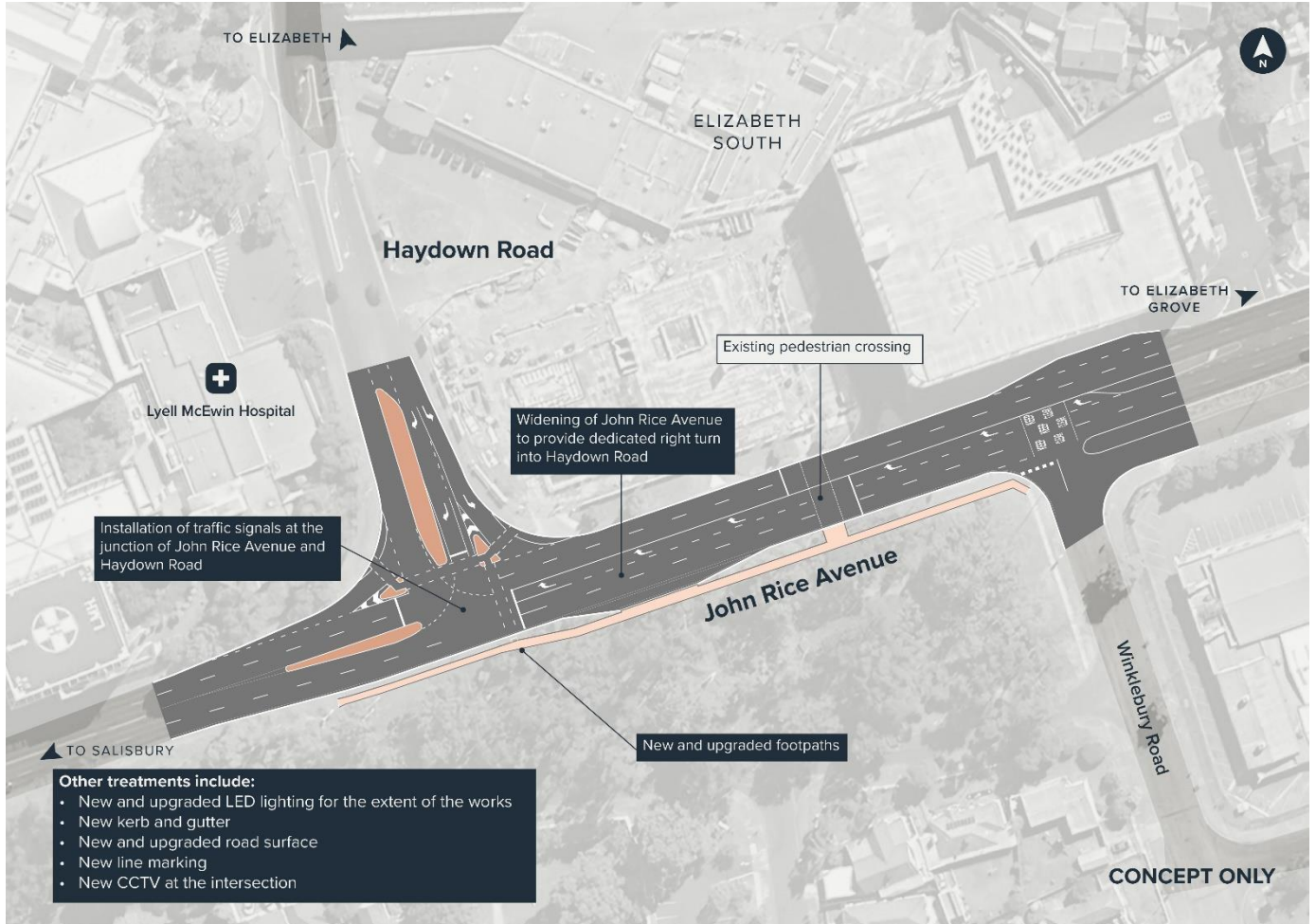

Final design

The design remains mostly unchanged with the installation of traffic lights and a dedicated right turn lane into Haydown Road.



Construction timing

Early works were completed in March 2024. Major construction is scheduled to commence in mid-2024, with project completion expected in early 2025. Advance notice will be provided before major works commence.
