

Tram Grade Separation Projects

Marion Road and Cross Road Level Crossing Removals

Glengyle Terrace, Night Works

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) funded \$400 million to remove the level crossings where the Glenelg tram line crosses Marion Road and Cross Road, Plympton. These works form part of the Tram Grade Separation Projects.

What's happening:

SAPN relocation works are required on Glengyle Terrace between Marion Road and Turner Avenue and will be undertaken at night.

Other investigation activities will continue to be required on Glengyle Terrace during the day as previously notified.

How this affects you:

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions and onsite signage.

During the relocation works, access into Glengyle Terrace from Marion Road will be closed while works are underway. A detour will be in place via Mabel Street.

Local access will be maintained to properties located within the vicinity of the works wherever possible with onsite traffic controllers available to assist. Some short-term access restrictions will be required with advance notice provided to impacted properties.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct you to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to the tram stop, Stop 10 Marion Road will be maintained during the works.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, however we will minimise noise where possible.
