# Tram Grade Separation Projects Marion Road and Cross Road Level Crossing Removals

### **Upcoming night works**

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) funded \$400 million to remove the level crossings where the Glenelg tram line crosses Marion Road and Cross Road, Plympton. These works form part of the Tram Grade Separation Projects.

## What's happening:

Service relocation works are continuing, with installation of new electrical poles and underground cables required at multiple locations on Marion Road and Anzac Highway.

## How this affects you:

Marion Road and Anzac Highway will remain open to traffic at all times. To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Please take care when travelling through the area and follow the direction of traffic controllers.

Pedestrians and cyclists may need to use a different path during the works. Signage will be in place to direct you to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained during the works, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, however we will minimise noise where possible.

Some minor outages may be required to facilitate these works. SAPN (phone: 13 12 61) will notify affected properties directly in advance.

Some minor activities will be required during the day as part of these works. These will occur Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm.

Two additional nights will be required in early September to finalise these activities, advance notice will be provided to surrounding properties.
