Morphett Road Level Crossing Removal

Service Relocations

We're raising the tram line over Morphett Road to get traffic moving

As part of the Tram Grade Separation Projects (TGSP), we are removing the level crossing at Morphett Road, Morphettville. This \$200 million level crossing removal project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

What's happening

We are relocating a number of services underground and installing new electrical poles on Morphett Road and Maxwell Terrace. These works are required ahead of construction works commencing in late 2024.

The services works will be undertaken in phases. Initial activities will include trenching to accommodate the new infrastructure.

Installation of the new electrical poles, and removal of existing poles, will start in late 2024. Advance notice of these works will be provided closer to the time.

How this affects you

To minimise impacts to traffic and trams, working hours will be a combination of day and night works. Night works will occur on Maxwell Terrace during this period and take around two weeks to complete. If these works are in close proximity to your property, we will contact you directly in advance.

Sunday 25 August to late October 2024 weather permitting

Typical work hours

Night works

Sunday to Friday
7pm to 6am

Some Saturday nights may be required.

Day works

Monday to Saturday
7am to 6pm

Where

Morphett Road between Anzac Highway and approx. 250m south of the level crossing including the footpath

Maxwell Terrace between Morphett Road and Sturt River

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions and onsite signage.

Access at the Morphett Road and Maxwell Terrace junction will be maintained wherever possible.

Some short-term closures may be required with a local detour in place. Please follow onsite signage and traffic controllers. Some short-term property access restrictions may be required, and advance notice will be provided to impacted properties. Outside of working hours, traffic will be fully reopened however some on-street parking may be temporarily impacted, please see onsite signage.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to show where to go.

Access to Tram Stop 12 (Morphett Road), will be maintained at all times and there will be no impacts to tram services.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, however we will minimise noise where possible.

Service relocations will occur in the footpath and verge along Morphett Road (western side) between Anzac Highway and approximately 250m south of the level crossing, as well as along Maxwell Terrace between Morphett Road and the Sturt River.
