We are improving safety, access and road amenity for road users within the Wallaroo Township.

What's happening

We are undertaking pavement rehabilitation works within the township of Wallaroo to improve safety and access.

The final surface layer and line marking works will commence from mid-October weather permitting.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to traffic conditions.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please drive with care, observe on site signage and follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Pedestrians and cyclists might also need to use a different path during these works. Where required, signage will be in place to direct you to alternative routes.

Outside of working hours, lane restrictions will be removed. Some speed restrictions will remain in place until all works are completed.

Minor noise and dust disturbances can be expected while works are being undertaken, but we will do our best minimise impacts as much as practically possible.
