Training Overview: Suburban Train Driver

This qualification is for a person employed as a Train Driver.

If you have previously completed training in this field and you would like to apply for credit transfer or Recognition of Prior Learning, please submit your records of training prior to commencement so credit transfer or RPL may be applied for where possible.

Duration

All classroom training will be delivered as a block (in succession) when you commence in your role. Final assessments will be scheduled after successful completion of workplace mentoring and driving experience - approximately 12-24 months.

Location

Locations will vary from classroom theory sessions to practical assessments being conducted on the job at rail stations around Adelaide.

The qualification consists of 21 units of competency 12 core units, 5 specialist units (Urban Electric) and 4 elective units.
