

# Stuart Highway, Glendambo Flood Remediation works

## Works Notice

### We are improving flood resilience on the Stuart Highway

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$75 million (80:20) over four years to fund the Flood Recovery Targeted Investment to Improve National Supply Chain Resilience program.

### What's happening

Flood recovery works, including pavement rehabilitation, asphaltting works and culvert excavation, will be undertaken on the Stuart Highway North of Glendambo.

### How this affects you

To safely undertake these works there will be changes to existing traffic conditions. Speed and lane restrictions in place throughout the area for the duration of the works. Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place until all works, including line marking, are complete in late June 2025.

**The Stuart Highway will remain open at all times.** Traffic may be reduced to a single lane intermittently as required. Please follow the direction of on-site traffic controllers and observe signage.

There may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during spray sealing work.
