

Wallaroo Roads Rehabilitation

Works notice

We are improving safety, access and road amenity for road users within the Wallaroo Township.

The project is jointly funded by the State Government and Copper Coast Council.

What's happening

Due to inclement weather and to minimise impacts to the grain harvest season, works on Magazine Road and Sharples Road have been rescheduled.

Remaining works, including the final surface layer and line marking works, will now be undertaken from Thursday 16 January 2025, weather permitting.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please drive with care, observe on site signage and follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, lane restrictions will be removed. Speed restrictions will remain in place as required until all works are complete in early February 2025.

Pedestrians and cyclists might also need to use a different path during these works. Where required, signage will be in place to direct you to alternative routes.

Minor noise and dust disturbances can be expected while works are being undertaken, but we will do our best to minimise impacts as much as practically possible.
