

Main North Road and Target Hill Road Junction Upgrade, Salisbury Heights

Night works

We are improving road safety and accessibility in the northern suburbs

As part of the State Government's election commitments, we are upgrading, or investigating potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and to make travel easier for all users.

What's happening

Works on the junction of Main North Road and Target Hill Road are underway and progressing well.

To minimise traffic impacts, night works are required to be undertaken to complete the next stage of works on Main North Road, adjacent Target Hill Road.

These works will include traffic signal and road lighting installation, and asphaltting works.

How this affects you

From late June 2025 until mid-July 2025, night works will be undertaken between the hours of 7pm and 6am from Sunday to Thursday. **No night works will be undertaken on Friday or Saturday nights.**

There will be intermittent lane restrictions on Main North Road throughout the project area, with speed restrictions in place.

Lane restrictions will be lifted outside of night work hours, with speed restrictions remaining in place as required.

Please drive with care, follow the directions of traffic controllers, and observe signage when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained. Advance notice will be provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
