

# Variable Message Sign Installation

## Works notice

### What's happening

Variable message signs (VMS) will be installed at 16 locations within the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) corridor and surrounding major travel routes.

The permanent signs will display live travel-time estimates to key locations, as well as alternative routes or roadworks notifications as needed (see Figure 1 for an example). This information will help drivers to make informed route decisions while on their journey.

### How this affects you

A VMS will be installed at **Anzac Highway, Keswick** (see Figure 2). The sign will be installed in the median, facing westbound traffic.

## Timing

Works are scheduled to begin in early/mid December 2025 and are expected to be complete by July 2026.

To minimise the impact to road users, the majority of works will be undertaken at night between the hours of 7pm and 6am, from Sunday to Thursday.

## Construction details

Works will be undertaken in stages and there will be periods of inactivity between each stage.

**Stage 1:** We will undertake civil works for the VMS foundation and electrical control cabinet. This will involve the installation of conduits under adjacent footpaths and the road, piling, concrete pours and the installation of crash cushions and guardrail. Vegetation relocations will also occur at this time. This stage is expected to take approximately two months.

**Stage 2:** We will install the electrical control cabinet and connect it to power. This stage is expected to take approximately one week.

**Stage 3:** We will install the VMS. Following testing and commissioning, it will become operational. This stage is expected to take approximately one week.

## Changed traffic conditions

Anzac Highway will remain open at all times during the works, with speed and lane restrictions in place.

Temporary impacts to bike paths through the work zone will occur while works are being undertaken.

Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed. However, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.

Access to businesses and residents will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
