Fact sheet

We are delivering the Adelaide Circuit Redevelopment Project.

In February 2026, the South Australian Government announced that the MotoGP™ Grand Prix of Australia will relocate from Victoria to a purpose-built street circuit in Adelaide in 2027.

The proposed \$96 million redeveloped circuit will host the world's first MotoGP™ Grand Prix event to be held on a city street circuit and the bp Adelaide Grand Final Supercars event from November 2027. It will also host the return of the Tour Down Under from 2028.

Using elements of the historic Adelaide Grand Prix circuit, the design has focused on:

- delivering a world-class racing circuit
- minimising impacts on the environment
- creating more opportunities for people to be active, connect and enjoy the Adelaide Park Lands

The Adelaide Circuit Redevelopment Project will also deliver significant enhancements to other key arts and community events in the Adelaide Park Lands, including new service infrastructure to support Adelaide Fringe venues at Gluttony and the Garden of Unearthly Delights.

In addition, the South Australian Government has worked collaboratively with the Conservation Council of SA on a package of Adelaide Park Lands greening, rewilding and revitalisation projects to restore habitat and strengthen biodiversity.

The proposed design is now available for feedback until 11:59 pm on Sunday, 20 September 2026. Feedback received will help finalise the detailed design.

Construction of the circuit is planned to start in December 2026.

The South Australian Motor Sport Board (SAMSB) is designing the redeveloped circuit and managing the motorsport events. The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is responsible for delivery of the circuit and associated infrastructure upgrades on behalf of SAMSB.
