

SAFETY UPGRADE OF GREENHILL ROAD AND PORTRUSH ROAD INTERSECTION, LINDEN PARK



Works are scheduled to commence May 2018 and to be completed by the end of June 2018, weather permitting.

These works aim to reduce the risk of rear end and left turn crashes, as well as to improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians.

To minimise inconvenience to road users and pedestrians, the majority of these works will be undertaken at night between 7pm and 6am.

All roads will remain open to traffic with a 25 km/h speed restriction in place while workers are on site. Lane and other speed restrictions may apply subject to on site conditions. Some traffic delays should be expected whilst construction takes place.

PORTRUSH RD

CITY OF BURNSIDE CIVIC CENTRE

Reinstatement of landscaping along Portrush Road.

Installation of a signalised sheltered left-turn lane from Portrush Road into Greenhill Road for motorists heading eastbound.

GREENHILL RD

Installation of a signalised left turn lane from Greenhill Road into Portrush Road for motorists heading southbound.

Installation of an Uninterrupted Power Supply to provide temporary backup power to the intersection in the event of a power outage.

Upgrading existing lighting to LED.
