Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken in the Happy Home Reserve, adjacent the Gawler rail corridor.

Locations: Adjacent the rail corridor, near Davis Street, Salisbury (see map overleaf).

When: Works will occur intermittently from Monday 18 May until 19 June, including two weekends listed below, weather permitting.

Working times:

- Monday to Friday between 7am and 7pm,
- Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 May, between 7am and 7pm,
- Saturday 6 June and Sunday 7 June, between 7am and 7pm.

Activities: Replacing the existing transmission tower with new transmission poles and wiring to support the electrification of the Gawler rail line.

Traffic / pedestrian management:

- Some increased traffic may be experienced on Davis Street and Lawrie Avenue, however no impacts to local parking or traffic conditions are anticipated.
- Pedestrian access along the Little Para River Trail (near Happy Home Reserve) will be maintained during the works, but will be diverted as required to accommodate the worksite.
- During the two weekends listed above, access to the Little Para River Trail adjacent the Gawler rail line will be closed intermittently for short periods of time during high risk works. Team members will be on site during these times to direct pedestrians and ensure the safety of both the public and workers.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses.
