



Torrens to Darlington

Ground Investigation Works

Ground investigation activities will be undertaken in your area in coming weeks. These activities are both geotechnical and hydrogeological and are a key part of the early works the Department for Transport and Infrastructure is undertaking for the next stage of the North-South Corridor, Torrens to Darlington Project.

This testing will help us to develop a comprehensive picture of the underlying soil and ground water conditions along the South Road corridor.

Location and timing

We will be carrying out investigations at Gertrude Street, Glandore.

Investigations works are expected to commence from Wednesday **14 July** for approximately one week and will be carried out between **7am** and **5pm**.

In the event that these works need to be rescheduled due to inclement weather or other circumstances outside of our control, we will advise you as soon as we have details.

Traffic restrictions

Gertrude Street will be subject to temporary parking, traffic and speed restrictions in the vicinity of the works. Local access will be maintained.

Signage will be in place to alert road users to the changes in traffic conditions

Road users are advised to take care when travelling through the area.
