

Station Refresh Program Works

Smithfield Railway Station

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is delivering improvement works at 14 stations along the Gawler rail line as part of the Gawler rail line Station Refresh Program. The \$20 million program of works is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Works at Smithfield Railway Station include asphalt and shelter repairs, repainting the platforms and shelters and the installation of new seating, LED platform lighting, rubbish bins, station name signage and a secure bike shelter.

Works will be carried out intermittently at the station from **Monday**, **27 September 2021**, **to the end of November 2021**, **weather permitting**. Hours of work are 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the work site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

There will be no impact to public transport services during these works as the line is currently closed as part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project. Substitute bus services will continue to operate during this time.
