South Eastern Freeway Heavy Vehicle Safety Review

Speed and lane restrictions, Portrush Road, Cross Road and Glen Osmond Road intersection

The South Australian Government has undertaken a comprehensive review of heavy vehicle safety on the South Eastern Freeway down-track (the city-bound lanes) between Crafers and the intersection of Cross Road, Portrush Road and Glen Osmond Road.

A survey of the underground utilities will shortly be undertaken to assist with continuing investigations. These works will take place on the Cross Road approach to Portrush Road and the intersection of Cross Road and Glen Osmond Road.

What to expect

Day investigation works are scheduled to occur on Monday, 24 July and Tuesday, 25 July 2023, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 9am and 5pm.

Night investigation works are scheduled to occur on Wednesday, 26 July and Thursday, 27 July 2023, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 8pm and 4:30am.

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place on Portrush Road, Cross Road, Mount Barker Road and Glen Osmond Road for the duration of these activities.

Please plan ahead, allow for extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

Motorists are advised to observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
