Roundabout Upgrades, Mount Gambier

Heavy Vehicle Detour

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway, from Tantanoola to the South Australian/Victorian border. The project forms part of the \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade program, which is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

As part of the program, the Department is upgrading four roundabouts on Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway) at O'Leary Road, Suttontown Road, Wehl Street North and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway) within the township of Mount Gambier. The works also include road pavement rehabilitation to improve safety and traffic efficiency along the Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway).

What to expect

Works within the township of Mount Gambier will commence at the Suttontown Road roundabout, from Thursday, 12 October 2023 with completion at this roundabout expected in mid-November 2023 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 5pm. Some work outside of these times may be required with advance notice provided.

Heavy vehicle detour update

From Tuesday, 17 October 2023, the heavy vehicle detour via Wandilo Road will be replaced with a new detour route via O'Leary Road, Pine Hall Avenue and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway). This will remain in place for the duration of the works at the Suttontown Road Roundabout. Please refer to map overleaf.

Road users are asked to please plan ahead to allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

The roundabout upgrades at other locations will be undertaken progressively to minimise disruption to traffic. The community will be provided advance notice prior to works commencing at the other locations.
