Cape Jervis and Kangaroo Island Ports Upgrade

Penneshaw Night Works

We are upgrading the Penneshaw and Cape Jervis ports, increasing the facilities' lifespan, and supporting continued ferry services between Kangaroo Island and the mainland. This project is funded by the South Australian Government.

What's happening:

Major construction works to upgrade the port infrastructure at Penneshaw are underway and we are making good progress. To ensure access to ferry services is maintained, night works will regularly be undertaken throughout the works program, in addition to the regular day works schedule.

From Tuesday 11 June 2024 rock anchor construction will be undertaken at night with completion expected in mid-July 2024, weather permitting.

Hours of operation

Night works between the hours of 7pm and 7am Monday to Saturday

Regular day works will continue from 7am and 7pm Monday to Saturday

Some Sunday work may be required

Penneshaw Harbor Precinct

How this affects you:

Some noise can be expected; however, we will make every effort to minimise impacts as much as possible. Lighting will be directed towards work areas only, and the noisiest works will be undertaken in the early evening where practicable. On site electronic signage is now in place in the Penneshaw port precinct and will be updated regularly to ensure residents and visitors are advised of upcoming night works.
