Night works and temporary Sturt Highway closure

We are improving safety and supporting regional economic growth

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler to improve safety and traffic efficiency for all road users.

What's happening

We are undertaking pavement rehabilitation works on the Sturt Highway in Truro between West Terrace and Wuttke Road to improve road safety and network reliability.

Early works will commence from Thursday, 17 October 2024, with major works commencing in late October 2024, weather permitting.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, traffic restrictions will be in place throughout the area for the duration of project. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours, with speeds reduced for the duration of works. Temporary traffic signals will be in place throughout work areas to control the flow of traffic.

During working hours, access to some side roads and individual property driveways within the work area may be temporarily restricted at times with local detours in place as works move progressively along the Sturt Highway.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained.

Advance notice of these closures will be provided directly to adjacent properties via our contractor, Fulton Hogan and via onsite signage. Outside of working hours, local detours will be removed and normal access restored.

Sturt Highway temporary closure and detour

From mid-November 2024 for approximately 2 weeks, the Sturt Highway will be closed between Dutton Mail Road and Eudunda Road, Truro, during working hours. All vehicles (including heavy vehicles) will be detoured along North Terrace. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane through the detour with traffic controllers in place to direct the flow of traffic. Local access to properties and businesses will be maintained, with minor delays to be expected.

Outside of working hours, the Sturt Highway will be reopened to two-way traffic, however speed restrictions will remain in place. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow onsite signage.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will minimise disturbance as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphalting works are underway.
