NOTICE OF CHANGES TO TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

New Eastern Parade and Grand Trunkway intersection, Port Adelaide

As part of the overall works for Stages 2 and 3 of the Port River Expressway project, the intersection of Eastern Parade and the Grand Trunkway will be realigned and opened to traffic on **Wednesday 25 October 2006**.

The new intersection has been constructed to incorporate the rail crossing of the existing eastern rail leg at Eastern Parade. This rail line provides access for rail operators to the Port Flat Rail Yard, Port Adelaide.

To improve safety for both motorists and rail operators, the new intersection will operate under traffic signals, rail level crossing signals and boom gates. The new intersection at Eastern Parade and the Grand Trunkway will commence operation under a 50kph speed limit.

Due to construction works being undertaken on Francis Street, Eastern Parade will continue to be a temporary detour for motorists travelling between the Port River Expressway Stage 1 at Eastern Parade and the Port Adelaide Centre, with a speed limitation of 50kph.

Motorists are advised that left turns into the Grand Trunkway for west-bound traffic will not be permitted until early November. Local access will continue to be provided for Symons & Clark and Incitec Pivot.
