Southern Ports Highway Safety Upgrades Work notice

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to the Southern Ports Highway

These works are jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (50:50) as part of the \$168 million Road Safety Program.

What's happening

Works on the Robe to Clay Wells Road, Bray, section of the Southern Ports Highway upgrade are progressing well, with the team preparing the road for the holiday period.

Throughout December, we will undertake road resurfacing works and install temporary line marking and signage to enable us to lift speed restrictions over the holiday break.

No works will be undertaken between Saturday 20 December 2025 and Monday 5 January 2026. Works will resume on Tuesday 6 January 2026. Speed limits will be reinstated, and lane restrictions lifted during this time.

How this affects you

The Southern Ports Highway, between Robe and Clay Wells Road, will remain open at all times.

To undertake this work safely, when works recommence Tuesday 6 January 2026, this section of the Southern Ports Highway will continue to be reduced to a single lane of traffic around works areas between Robe and the Clay Wells Road intersection at Bray for the duration of works. Traffic signals and pilot vehicles will be in place to direct the flow of traffic around works areas.
