

Brighton Road, Ocean Boulevard and Scholefield Road Junction Upgrade

Site investigation works

We are upgrading the Brighton Road, Ocean Boulevard and Scholefield Road junction in Seacliff Park.

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments as part of the Brighton Road Intersection Improvements Project.

What's happening

We are undertaking site investigation works, including service locating and geotechnical works along Brighton Road, Ocean Boulevard and Scholefield Road at various sites.

These activities will help inform the project design.

How this affects you

To safely carry out these works, some speed and lane restrictions will be in place during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

We'll maintain access for properties throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access for safety. We'll put up signs to guide you to other routes if needed.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.
