

40 km/h school speed limits

Works notice – Seacombe Road

Improving safety for children travelling to and from school

A new 40 km/h time-based speed limit has been introduced near schools on South Australian roads that have speed limits of 50 km/h or higher. This will improve children's safety and help them when they travel to and from school.

As a result of the program, timed reduced speed limits will apply on Seacombe Road, in the vicinity of Seaview High School upon completion of the works.

What's happening

Works will be taking place on Seacombe Road, between Morphet Road and Miller Street, to install new electronic and static signage as part of the 40 km/h school speed limits rollout.

To optimise construction activities and minimise disruption, works will be undertaken intermittently between September and November 2026.

The project will be completed in stages, with civil works for the sign footings undertaken first, followed by the installation of the poles and signs. While there may be periods where no work is visible on site, this staged approach helps minimise disruption and ensures works can be completed safely and effectively.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe while works are undertaken, there will be changes to traffic conditions. Speed restrictions and lane closures will be in place during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Some noise, vibration, and dust disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of works on local residents and road users during this time.

Property access will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

There may be some impacts to street parking around the work zone, as required. Please observe signage and follow the direction of workers if your vehicle needs to be moved.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during works.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling throughout the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternate access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Please be aware that works are dependent on weather conditions and may also be impacted by other unforeseen factors.

40 km/h school speed limits

The new 40 km/h time-based school speed limit will be in place along Seacombe Road during the following times on school days:

- 8:00am to 9:30am
- 2:00pm to 4:00pm

This excludes weekends, public holidays and school holidays.

Speed limits will be enforced from the date of completion at each site.
