

Strategic Asset Management Advisory Services

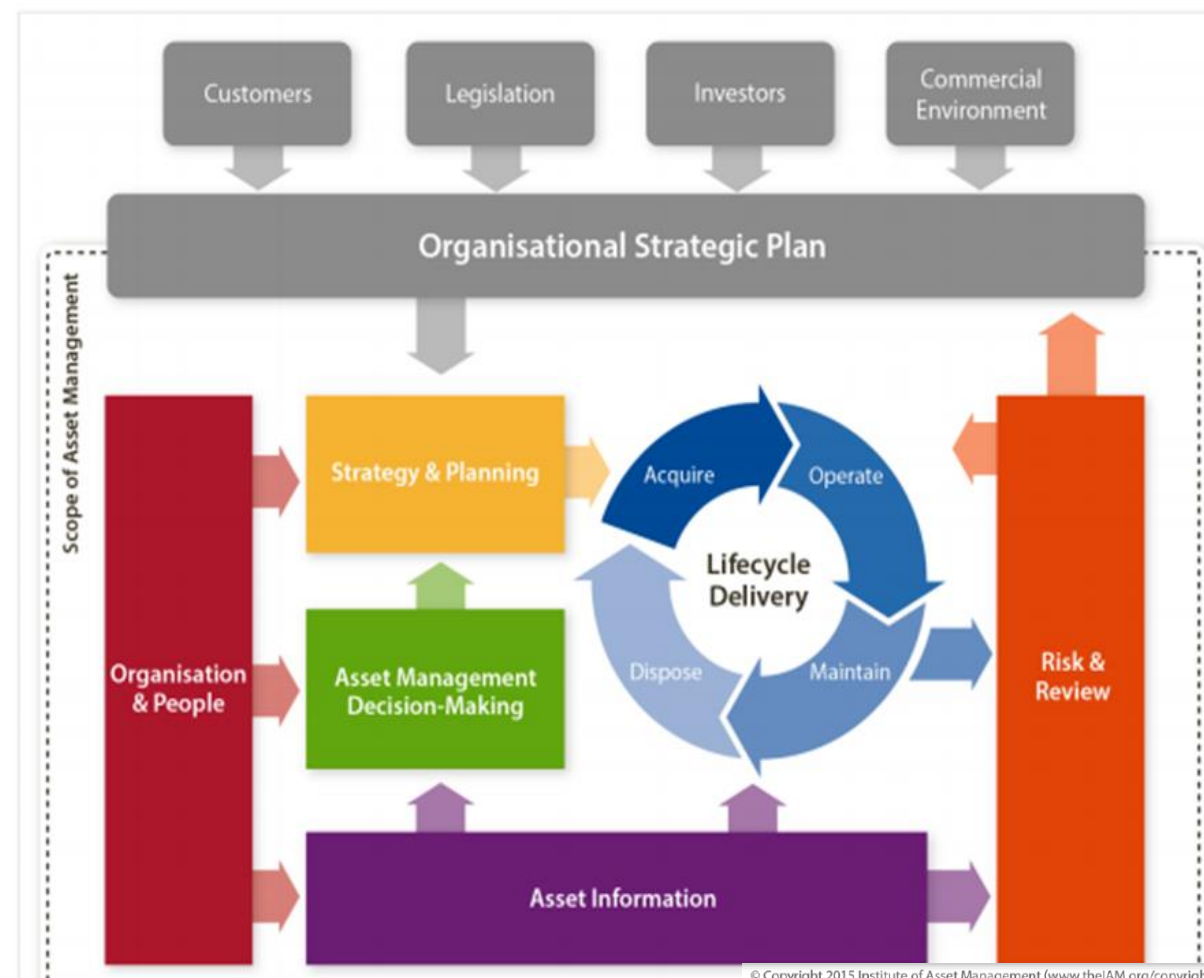
Provide whole of government strategic building asset management advice to enhance the performance and management of public sector building assets.
