Gorge Road and Silkes Road Junction Upgrade

Upcoming night works and temporary road closure

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be improving safety and traffic flow at the junction of Gorge Road and Silkes Road, Paradise. This \$3.6 million project is being delivered by the State Government to improve safety for all road users.

As part of the project, asphalting works will be undertaken in two stages at the Gorge Road junctions with Silkes Road and Pattinson Road. To ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently, the majority of works will be undertaken at night.

Stage one night works will be undertaken from Tuesday, 2 November to Saturday, 6 November 2021, between 7pm and 6am, weather permitting. Gorge, Silkes and Pattinson roads will remain open during the works with temporary speed and lane restrictions in place. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Stage two will be undertaken on Friday, 12 November 2021, between 7pm and 6am, weather permitting. A temporary road closure will be in place at the Gorge Road junctions with Silkes Road and Pattinson Road with detours in place from 9:30pm to 5:30am, see map for details.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

There is no change to public transport services.

The Department appreciates your patience while this important work is undertaken.
