Tonsley Bridge Hanger Installation Works

The Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project is the final 10.5 km section of South Australia's world-class multi-billion dollar North-South Corridor.

What we're doing

In early-January 2022 the Department for Infrastructure and Transport will be undertaking works on the underside of the Tonsley Bridge, to support a new gas main across South Road. This is part of the early works required to enable the construction of the southern tunnels.

Location and timing

We will be carrying out work on the underside of Tonsley Bridge, South Road, between Tonsley and St Marys. Works are expected to commence Wednesday 5 January 2022 and continue for approximately one week, weather permitting. They will be carried out nightly between 8pm and 7am, Monday to Friday (inclusive). We're working at night to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of our workers.

Traffic Restrictions

- Lane and speed restrictions will apply in the Southern Expressway between Ayliffes Road and Selgar Avenue.
- Northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane from Ayliffes Road.
- Southbound traffic will be reduced to one lane from Tobruk Avenue. Access to the lowered motorway for southbound motorists will be maintained from the Ayliffes Road intersection.

What to expect

During works you may notice additional ground and traffic management personnel and equipment within the area. Some disturbances can be expected such as noise, dust and vibration. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.
