# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

# Update - Ongoing night works

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As previously advised in late August 2023, night works will continue to be undertaken as required until project completion in late 2023. In addition to these works, night works will be undertaken for essential services work. To minimise impacts to road users, work will be undertaken at night between 7pm and 6am on **Friday**, **22 September 2023 and Friday**, **29 September 2023, weather permitting**.

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care and follow directional signage when travelling through the area.

### **Traffic changes**

During the works, the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times.

To safely undertake these works, lane and speed restrictions will be in place along Glen Osmond Road, Fullarton Road and intersecting side streets. Local road closures may be required during works and local detours will be in place. Advance notice will be provided.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained. In the event that access restrictions are necessary, property owners will be notified in advance by the project team.

#### **Noise and vibration**

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphalting works are underway.
