

Bakewell Underpass

Investigation works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is undertaking investigation works on the concrete surface of the Bakewell underpass at Mile End.

These investigations will help inform planned restoration works on the concrete surface of the underpass. This will include cosmetic repairs to retaining wall cracks within the underpass, on both sides of Henley Beach Road/Glover Avenue. Advance notice will be provided ahead of the restoration works commencing.

What to expect

These investigation works are expected to **commence from Tuesday, 17 October 2023 and are expected to be completed in early November**, weather permitting.

To reduce impacts to the local community and road users, these works **will be undertaken at night, Monday to Friday, between 7pm and 6am**. No works will be undertaken on weekends.

To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place intermittently on Henley Beach Road / Glover Avenue, as required during work hours. **The road will remain open to traffic at all times.**

Outside of work hours, all speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

Please follow the directions of on-site traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site.

Access will be maintained for emergency services vehicles and public transport at all times.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling more intrusive works in the early evening, where possible.

Pedestrian and cyclist detour

To safely facilitate these works, the existing footpath on the southern side of Henley Beach Road / Glover Avenue will be **closed each night during work hours**. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative routes. Please see map overleaf. Outside of work hours, the footpath will be reopened for full access.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.
