

The South Australian and Australian governments have committed \$8.7 million to deliver an improved Thebarton Aquatic Centre for the community to enjoy.

Project Progress

Since the start of works in September 2023, construction has been progressing well with several project milestones recently achieved.

These milestones include:

- demolition works including decommissioning of services, removal of cladding and the existing concourse;
- installation of underground services;
- concrete slabs and structural steel installation; and
- roofing works to main pool area.

Key features include:

- upgraded pools patching and retiling works and repainting of the pools;
- a re-constructed pool concourse including a new wet deck, improved drainage and slip resistance tiles / tactiles;
- new change rooms with more toilets and showers – more than 50% increase in facilities;
- a new open space at the south of the pool hall;
- more modern pool equipment that is easier to service and maintain;
- a new Lifesaver office and first aid room with direct view and access to the pool deck;
- larger pool equipment storage area;
- building upgrades including new walls, painting and roofing; and
- two new multi-purpose areas.



The installation of the roof to the south and west structures is currently in progress.

It is anticipated the roof will be fully enclosed by mid-April 2024.

What's next


Installation of brickwork, windows, doors and cladding.

Upgrade work on the pools which will include repairs to fibreglass, tiling and painting works.

The refurbished Thebarton Aquatic Centre is scheduled to reopen in mid-2024.
