

# South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrades

## Onkaparinga Valley Road, Balhannah

We are upgrading a series of bridges and culverts across regional South Australia to extend the service life of the structures and improve safety for road users.

### What's happening:

Works to upgrade the bridge over Junction Creek in Balhannah are continuing. Changed traffic conditions will remain in place, with traffic to be moved into the eastbound lanes. Some vegetation removal on the southern side of Onkaparinga Valley Road will also occur in May 2024 to facilitate the next stage of bridge construction.

### How this affects you:

**To safely facilitate these works, traffic will continue to be reduced to a single lane on Onkaparinga Valley Road with temporary traffic signals in place to control the direction of traffic.**

Speed restrictions will also be in place throughout the work area for the duration of the project. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Please continue to observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Please see map overleaf for details. During the works, there will be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

All works are expected to be complete in September 2024. We would like to thank you for your ongoing patience whilst these works are undertaken.
