Main South Road Upgrades, Myponga to Second Valley

We are upgrading Main South Road from Myponga to Second Valley, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. These works form part of the \$168 million Road Safety Program 2023-2025, jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments.

What's happening:

Safety barriers are being installed at various locations between Myponga and Second Valley.

How this affects you:

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work areas during work hours. Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

Please take care when traveling through the area and follow the directions of traffic controllers.

Main South Road will remain open at all times.
