Demolition works

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$85 million (50:50) towards an upgrade of the intersection of Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive.

Demolition works are continuing to facilitate the intersection upgrade.

What's happening:

Demolition works on the corner of Sir Donald Bradman Drive and Marion Road will commence from early July to help prepare the area.

In the event these works need to be rescheduled due to weather conditions or other circumstances outside of our control, we will advise you as soon as we have details.

How this affects you:

When

Monday 8 July to mid August 2024, weather permitting

Hours of operation

7am to 6pm Monday to Friday

Where

Corner of Sir Donald Bradman Drive and Marion Road, Brooklyn Park (see map overleaf)

Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive intersection will remain open to traffic at all times with temporary speed restrictions in place as required.

To keep everyone safe there will be changes to pedestrian access along Marion Road, at the south western corner of the intersection. A detour will be in place for the duration of the works period. Please follow onsite signage and the direction of traffic controllers around the alternative route (see map overleaf).

Prior to the demolition works starting, temporary fencing will be installed around the property.

An asbestos and hazard assessment will also be completed prior to demolition and any identified hazards will be removed. All asbestos and hazardous material removal works will be carried out by a licensed contractor in accordance with the Environment Protection Authority Guidelines. These measures will ensure the safety of the community and workers.

Some disturbance can be expected such as noise, dust and vibration associated with the demolition and removal of structural elements, supporting foundations and hardstand areas but we will ensure we minimise these impacts as much as possible.

What you need to do:


Pedestrians

The footpath on Marion Road south of the intersection will remain closed throughout the demolition works. The footpath on Sir Donald Bradman Drive up to the intersection crosswalk will remain open at all times, see map.

All road users

Please observe temporary speed restrictions and be aware of additional truck and large vehicle movements within the area. Plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.
