Port Wakefield Overpass Lighting Installation

We are reducing traffic congestion and improving road safety on the Augusta Highway.

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$124.5 million (80:20) to the Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication Project.

What's happening

We are installing new lighting under the Port Wakefield Overpass, to improve road safety for all road users.

How this affects you

To do this work safely, we will have speed and lane restrictions in place throughout work areas including on the Port Wakefield/Augusta Highway.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Outside of work hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

The Port Wakefield Highway, Augusta Highway, and Copper Coast Highway will remain open at all times.
