Operating Surplus Ratio

Operating Surplus / (Deficit) (see report 3) divide by Total Operating Income (see report 2)

As per SA LGGC Supplementary Return/Financial Statements

A positive ratio indicates the percentage of operating income available to help fund proposed capital expenditure. If the relevant amount is not required for this purpose in a particular year, it can be held for future capital expenditure needs by either increasing financial assets or preferably, where possible, reducing debt in the meantime.

A negative ratio indicates the percentage increase in operating income or the approximate decrease in operating expenses required to achieve a break-even operating result.

This indicator is by far the most important financial indicator for Councils. If a council constantly achieves a modest positive operating surplus ratio, and has soundly based projections showing that it can continue to do so in future, having regard to asset management and its community service level needs, then it is financially sustainable. Favourable trend results measured against other financial indicators described below will assist, but not in themselves ensure, that a Council operates sustainably.

Adjusted Operating Surplus Ratio

Operating Surplus Ratio adjusted to remove the impact of both the brought forward 2022-23 payment (estimated three instalments) of financial assistance grants that were received by Councils in April 2022, the brought forward 2023-24 payment (estimated four instalments) of financial assistance grants that were received by Councils in June 2023.

Net Financial Liabilities Ratio

Net Financial Liabilities (see report 7) divide by Total Operating Income (see report 2) As per SA LGGC Supplementary Return/Financial Statements

Net financial liabilities is a broader and more appropriate measure of indebtedness than the level of borrowings, because it includes items such as employee long-service leave entitlements and other amounts payable as well as taking account of a Council's cash and investments

The net financial liabilities ratio is calculated by expressing net financial liabilities at the end of a financial year as a percentage of operating income for the year. If the ratio falls, over time, this indicates that the Council's capacity to meet its financial obligations from operating income is strengthening.

Adjusted Net Financial Liabilities Ratio

Net Final Liabilities Ratio adjusted to remove the impact of the brought forward 2022-23 payment (estimated three instalments) of financial assistance grants that were received by Councils in April 2022, the brought forward 2023-24 payment (estimated four instalments) of financial assistance grants that were received by Councils in June 2023.

Asset Renewal Funding Ratio

Capital Expenditure on Renewal/ Replacement of Existing Assets divide Optimal Level of Capital Expenditure on Renewal and Replacing Assets

As per Council's Annual Financial Statements

This ratio indicates the extent to which non-financial assets are being renewed and replaced, compared with the asset renewal and replacement expenditure identified as warranted in a Council's infrastructure and asset management plan (I&). It is calculated by measuring capital expenditure on renewal or replacement of assets, relative to the optimal level of such expenditure proposed in a Council's infrastructure and asset management plan (I&).

The Asset Sustainability Ratio has been sourced direct from council's Annual Financial Statements due to differences to data reported in the supplementary return. Note that the Optimal Level of Capital Expenditure on Renewal and Replacing Assets (as per Infrastructure and Asset Management Plan) should be used as the denominator in calculating the Asset Sustainability Ratio indicator. An Asset Sustainability Ratio is not displayed where depreciation has been incorrectly used as the denominator.
- 4. To ensure a focus on Councils' underlying operating result, the Adjusted Operating Surplus Ratio includes adding back the amount associated with three 2022-23 quarterly instalments of Federal Financial Assistance Grants received by Councils in April 2022 and recorded as income in 2021-22 and deducting the amount associated with four 2023-24 quarterly instalments of Federal Financial Assistance Grants received by Councils in June 2023 and recorded as income in 2022-23 (in accordance with AASB 1004). Where a Council did not comply with AASB 1004, no adjustment to this ratio is required. Similarly, the Adjusted Net Financial Liabilities Ratio removes the distortion otherwise caused by the early receipt of 2022-23 Financial Assistance Grants in April 2022 and 2023-24 Financial Assistance Grants in June 2023
- 5. The net financial liabilities ratio of the District Council of Coober Pedy is severely distorted by the accounting treatment (under Australian Accounting Standards) of right-of-use assets associated with electricity supply services. These services are better than cost neutral for the Council because of large State Government subsidies under the Remote Areas Energy Supplies (RAES) Scheme. Therefore, all financial data associated with electricity activities has been removed in calculating the adjusted net financial liabilities ratio.
- 6. While no attempt is made in this report to adjust for the impact of additional one-off grants received by councils under the Federal Roads to Recovery Program in 2022-23, any consideration of the underlying operating result of a council should have regard to this (noting that many councils have done so in their annual financial statements and other reporting).

Also, it is often not meaningful to view data without an understanding or explanation of the differing financial and asset management strategies and targets of each Council.
