

# Grand Junction Road and Montrose Avenue, Gepps Cross Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

## Early works

**We are making it safer and more convenient for pedestrians and cyclists to cross Grand Junction Road**

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, urban roads, footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia.

The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments over three years.

## What's happening

We are installing a new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing (BPAC) on Grand Junction Road, near Montrose Avenue, Gepps Cross.

Service relocation works are now required in preparation for the commencement of major works later this year.

## How this affects you

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place.

During work hours Grand Junction Road, westbound, will be reduced to two lanes, and the junction of Montrose Avenue and Grand Junction Road will be closed to all traffic with local access detours in place for the duration of the project. Please plan your trips, observe signage and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

Grand Junction Road, between Austral Avenue and Montrose Avenue, Gepps Cross
