

Freight Highway Upgrade Program

Dukes Highway – Site investigation works

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

The \$500 million 10-year program is funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening

We are undertaking geotechnical investigations around the junction of Dukes Highway and Mallee Highway, Taillem Bend. These works will help inform our transport planning for future improvements to this section of the highway.

How this affects you

To safely carry out these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed restrictions and temporary lane closures will be in place on Dukes Highway and Mallee Highway during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

We'll maintain access for properties throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to restrict driveway access temporarily.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during the works.
