

Penneshaw Public Jetty Upgrade

Project update

We are rebuilding the Penneshaw Public Jetty to increase the structures lifespan and improve safety and access for all users

What's happening

Work on the new Penneshaw Public Jetty will begin in mid-February 2026. The jetty upgrade will improve safety by realigning the jetty away from the busy ferry terminal. Works will include:

- A new concrete boardwalk connecting to the historical timber jetty for improved safety
- New steel piles
- Refurbishment of remnant timber jetty
- New lighting
- Removal of the temporary cruise ship landing and crane pad.

The refreshed cruise ship landing area and public access to the jetty will be open in time for the 2026/27 cruise season.

The environment

We recognise the importance of protecting marine life and the natural environment on Kangaroo Island. Appropriate measures will be put in place to ensure that construction and operations are carried out responsibly.

We are committed to protecting the environment by using sustainable practices, completing environmental assessments, choosing suitable construction methods, and working closely with relevant stakeholders to reduce any negative impacts.

How this affects you

During works some noise can be expected, however we will make every effort to minimise impacts as much as possible. The majority of work will be undertaken during the daytime however some intermittent night work will be required to avoid impacting ferry services.

The construction lay down area will be adjacent to the SeaLink ferry terminal and will remain in place until all works are complete. Access and parking to the area will at times be restricted. Advanced notice will be provided.
