

Kings Road BPAC and Shared Use Path, Salisbury Downs

Project Update

We are improving safety and connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists on Kings Road in Salisbury Downs

The new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing (BPAC) on Kings Road, adjacent to the Gawler railway corridor in Salisbury Downs, is now operational.

What's happening

Works on the new Bicycle and Pedestrian Actuated (push button) Crossing on Kings Road are now complete, and the new signals are operational.

The old crossing located approximately 160 metres west of the railway crossing will now be permanently removed.

How this affects you

Works to remove the crossing will take approximately two weeks.

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of work hours lane restrictions will be lifted with speed restrictions remaining in place at all times until completion.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through work zones. Some areas might have limited access to ensure safety. Onsite signage will guide you to other routes if needed.

Works on the new Shared Use Path are expected to commence in early 2027 with advance notice provided.
