

Freight Highway Upgrade Program

Augusta Highway and Horrocks Pass Road junction upgrade

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes

What's happening

Works to improve safety and traffic movements at the junction of the Augusta Highway and Horrocks Pass Road are ongoing and progressing well.

The northbound and southbound rest areas near the junction are open and the new overtaking lane is now operational.

The next stage of safety upgrades, including safety barrier installation, are underway with completion expected in September 2026, weather permitting.

Some pavement remediation works are required and must be undertaken during the drier months of summer. These works will commence later in 2026 and require the temporary closure of the overtaking lane. Onsite signage will provide advance notification before this work commences.

How this affects you

The Augusta Highway will remain open to traffic at all times.

For everyone's safety, speed restrictions will remain in place throughout the area until all works are completed in late 2026.

Intermittent lane restrictions will be in place during safety barrier installation and pavement remediation works as required. Please follow onsite traffic signage and the directions of traffic controllers.
