

Tea Tree Plaza Interchange

Project update – August 2026

We are undertaking resurfacing works on the bus roadway at Tea Tree Plaza Interchange

What's happening

To complete the final resurfacing works sooner and reduce overall disruption, Tea Tree Plaza Interchange will temporarily close for three weeks, from 6:00 pm Friday 14 August until first service on Friday 4 September 2026. Works will continue day and night throughout the closure.

The interchange will reopen in time for the Royal Adelaide Show. Minor finishing works may continue during September and are expected to have minimal impact on Adelaide Metro passengers and the community.

How this affects you

These works will generate noise, but we will do our best to minimise disruption. You may also notice odours at times, which is normal during asphalt works.

At times, work may be less visible while activities such as curing, testing and quality checks are underway. These steps help ensure the pavement is durable and reliable for years to come.

Bus stops and access

There will be no pedestrian or bus access to the interchange during the closure period. Buses will operate from temporary stops on the northern side of Smart Road. Access to Tea Tree Plaza, the Interchange Park 'n' Ride, and surrounding residential and business properties will be maintained throughout the closure.
