3. Project update – Matt Saviana

Traffic Switch 4A

- Due for late October 2017
- 4 lane surface road will have 2 long term lanes, and 2 temporary.
- There will be no traffic closures during the switch, with traffic to be diverted to Marion Road via temporary traffic lights.
- Adjacent to Bedford Park there will be 4 lanes between Lincoln St. and SEXY
- Further down 8 lanes to prepare for future works

Traffic Switch 4B

- Due for late 2017/early 2018
- Traffic on Ayliffes Road will be split to create space to build non-stop motorway
- Ayliffes Flyover bridge construction will take 12 months
