



Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Night works within the rail corridor

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, night works within the rail corridor are necessary to undertake essential track stressing works.

Location: works will occur within the rail corridor between Para Road, Evanston and Howard Street, Gawler.

When: works will be undertaken for three nights from Wednesday, 24 November 2021, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 6pm and 6am. Due to the nature of the works, it is important that these activities occur at night when the rail line is cool and not heated by daytime temperatures or direct sunlight.

What you can expect: the works will involve cutting, adjusting and welding rail track back together through a process called “stressing.”

As the crews move along the rail line, medium to high levels of noise can be expected when the machinery is in close proximity to your property. While track works can be noisy and dusty, they are necessary to ensure durability of the track and are an important part of ensuring good track condition.

You may experience some vibration and hear noise from rail equipment, machinery, vehicle movements and essential communication between workers, however every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during these works.
