

Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Asphalt weekend works update – Stage 2

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As previously advised, asphalt works are being undertaken within the new intersection in stages, across a series of full weekends throughout the month of February 2023. The first stage of works was completed on 3, 4 and 5 February 2023.

The next stage will be undertaken in the north-western quadrant of the intersection, from **7pm Friday, 10 February, both day and night until 6am Monday, 13 February 2023, weather permitting.**

What to expect

To safely facilitate these works and manage traffic flows, speed and lane restrictions will be in place across the intersection with different traffic arrangements in place during night shifts and day shifts across the weekend. Please see details below:

The following traffic arrangements will be in place during **night shifts, Friday, 10 February and Saturday 11, February between 7pm – 7am and Sunday, 12 February 2023, between 7pm and 6am:**

- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Euston Avenue;
- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Ringarooma Avenue; and
- traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Night works' for details of the above arrangements.

The following traffic arrangements will be in place **during day shifts Saturday, 11 and Sunday, 12 February between 7am and 7pm:**

- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Euston Avenue;
- right turns will not be permitted in or out of Ringarooma Avenue; and
- two lanes of traffic will operate in each direction.

Refer to the map overleaf titled 'Day works' for details of the above arrangements.

The pedestrian crossing on Cross Road, on the western side of the intersection, will be closed during the works for safety reasons. Pedestrians will need to use the pedestrian crossing on the eastern side of the intersection.

Traffic controllers will be on-site to assist pedestrians and signage will be in place. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area.

Bus stop 12 (western side) on Fullarton Road will be temporarily closed during the works.

There may be some short-term access impacts to properties on Cross Road in the work area, during night works. Traffic controllers will assist with access if this occurs.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

Emergency services vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Permanent access changes

As outlined in our previous notification, '*Asphalt weekend works – Stage 1*', right turn movements at Ringarooma Avenue, Euston Avenue and Hexham Avenue are being permanently removed as part of the upgraded intersection. The removal of these movements is required to provide improved traffic flow, efficiency and safety through the upgraded Cross Road/Fullarton Road intersection.

These movements will be permanently removed from 6am Monday, 13 February 2023.
