Engage with and support the Expert Panel with data, evidence, and information	<ul> <li>In August 2022, the Minister for Planning commissioned an independent panel of planning experts to conduct a review of reforms to the planning system implementation, including: <ul> <li>The Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016.</li> <li>The Planning and Design Code and related instruments, as it relates to infill policy, trees, character, heritage and car parking.</li> <li>The ePlanning system, to ensure it is delivering an efficient and user-friendly process and platform.</li> <li>The PlanSA website, to check usability and ease of community access to information.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The Expert Panel recently completed its nine-week formal community engagement period. Submissions to the Panel closed in December 2022.</li> <li>In the coming months, the Expert Panel will provide recommendations to enhance the State's planning system to the Minister for Planning.
